

1 Pray for our various producers, that God's grace will abound more and more upon their lives and for God's divine security upon their families.

2 Continue to pray for the five new TWT (*Truth for Today*) languages in production. They are Goun, Juba Arabic, Senoufo, Kirundi and Yao.

3 Pray that God will open more opportunities for VOC 2, the English Channel of VOC (*Voice of the Church*), to air its programmes on local FM stations.

4 Praise God for the *Litala Iya Umi (The Way of Life)* programme that is airing from our TWR transmitting station in Eswatini (*Swaziland*) and the listener responses. Pray for the continuation of its broadcast.

5 Let us pray for TWR's development of Zulu children's programmes, and that children will get to know Jesus as their Friend through these broadcasts.
