2 Please pray for the Nigeria ministry consultation meeting planned for this month with around ten TWR people participating / planning for the new service.

3 Today is Petros Gwala's birthday. May the Lord encourage him as he gives leadership to the Zulu ministry in KwaZulu Natal (KZN), South Africa.

4 Today is Lorraine Stravopoulos's birthday. Ask God to guide her as she serves Him alongside Steve in Eswatini. Pray for good health, a closer walk with the Lord and joy.

5 We praise God for the successful process of combining conversations, prayers, testimonials and fund-raising on-air in last year's TWR's inaugural SHINE Africa event. Let's pray that God continues to grant wisdom to the team involved to ensure success in this year's SHINE Africa event next month.

6 Pray for peace amongst the population of Benin, during the local elections.

7 Pray for missions and missionaries in Nigeria, especially in the North. Many mission agencies have been forced to withdraw their teams for safety as they are being killed and some kidnapped.

9 Please pray for YDCS, our partner in Ethiopia to take advantage of the much improved internet system and progress in the country and improve their communication with partners, including TWR.

10 Thully Sitole, our cleaning lady at TWR-KZN is celebrating her birthday today. Pray that the Lord gives her wisdom and strength in her personal life.

11 Pray for a project proposal to *Thru the Bible* (TTB) to reach out to French speakers in East Africa and large parts of Central Africa through Short Wave (SW). Many parts of East and Central Africa can still mainly be reached by SW.

12 Today is International Nurses Day, the anniversary of Florence Nightingale's birth. The theme for this year is Nurses: *A voice to lead - Health for All*. Pray for the provision of sanitation, clean water and medical care for the people in Africa.

13 Praise God for our Ugandan partner that is using TWR programmes to reach out to the Nubian people who were exclusively followers of another religion. We praise God that some home churches have been started.

14 Pray for God's favour on the *Knowing God* drama series distribution in Suba land, Northern Tanzania. Pray for the many lives that are being touched by the programme, to be receptive and surrender to the leading of the Holy Spirit.

15 Today is International Day of Families. The day highlights the importance of all caregivers in families. Tune in to TWR and listen to a daily series of Focus on the Family broadcasts that provides encouragement to help families thrive each day.

16 Continue to pray for the Oasis Transmitter Project and the team members to cope well with the stress of a large project.

17 Today is the birthday of Lyn Burnett, TWR Women of Hope Coordinator, SA. Pray that the Lord will bless and keep her and fill her life with His joy, strength and courage.

18 Praise God for the provision towards getting TWR Burundi to acquire new office and studio premises. Pray that more people in Burundi get to listen to TWR programmes.

19 Let us pray for listeners who respond to TWR-KZN programmes, many of whom ask for prayer for dire needs in their lives.

26 Pray for the improvements and reliability of TWR's network connections in parts of Africa. Pray for a suitable solution to be found as the absence of network restricts the distribution of new programmes.

27 Pray for the unity of the Church in Nigeria plagued by sectarianism and partisanship. Pray that the Church will be an effective and faithful witness of Christ.

28 Please join in prayer for the Oasis Transmitter Project team that are devoted to the smooth running of the project; that God will continue to bless and grant them grace to continue in their selfless sacrifice to the advancement of the Kingdom of God in West Africa.

29 Pray that God will intervene and end the current spate of insecurity, kidnappings, wanton killings and terror attacks ongoing in several parts of West Africa, by the Boko Haram terrorist group, Fulani Jihadist/herdsmen and foreign mercenaries from Mali, Niger and Chad.

30 Please pray that God will continue to strengthen the *Thru the Bible* (TTB) team in Kumasi, as they continue to labour for a great harvest of souls in that region of Ghana. Through their ministry, hundreds are won or re-committed to the Lord every month.

31 Please pray for the security of Burkina Faso which regularly undergoes assaults from armed bands. The country has seen a major increase in attacks from extremist groups of different religions in the past few years.
