

Prayer calendar for June 2019



1 Let us rejoice and pray for Gail Dippenaar as she celebrates her birthday today. Ask God to guide her as she serves Him at TWR as Compiler Manager, and for good health.

2 Today is International Cancer Survivors Day. Pray for TWR staff and listeners who have family members suffering from cancer.

3 Please pray for more to be done to end child marriages by educating parents and leaders on how this cultural practice destroys lives, harms communities, and continues the cycle of poverty as the world observes an International Day of Innocent Children - Victims of Aggression.

4 Today is the birthday of Thulani Mdletshe, TWR Presenter, South Africa. Pray that the Lord will richly bless and keep him and fill his life with His joy, strength and courage.

5 Pray for the smooth broadcasts of the SHINE Africa campaign – that our “*LIGHT (will) SHINE before others that they may see your good deeds and glorify your father in heaven*”.

6 Ask God to motivate people to be involved in the SHINE Africa campaign during the broadcasts and that He will move listeners to communicate and give to TWR Africa.

7 June is Youth month in South Africa. We praise God for the young people who take time to listen to TWR programmes. Pray that more youth will open their hearts to God’s Word and to receive messages of hope.

8 Please pray for Eberhard Haberkorn and Gottfried Schiele for safe travel, good health and protection during their outreach in Namibia next month.

9 Today is World Day to Combat Desertification and Drought. Continue to pray for all African countries that are facing drought, especially farming areas.

10 Please pray for the publicity of TWR-Africa App’s on Android and iOS to appeal to App users. Pray that the Word of God may reach them in the platforms of their choice.

11 Praise be to God for the Afrikaans TTB programme *Die Bybel vir Vandag (DBVV)* that is broadcast from Channel 7 in Namibia. Thank God for this wonderful opportunity and the willingness of the radio station to broadcast it.

12 Today is World Refugee Day. Please pray that God would reach refugees in Africa through TWR’s broadcasts, and comfort them in their distress as they listen to the programmes.

13 Continue to pray for the Oasis Transmitter Project and for wisdom and strength for the team members involved as they work diligently to bring this project to its completion.

14 Please pray that the Lord would meet the needs of TWR. With missionary staff worldwide, powerful radio stations to maintain, and offices in many countries, personnel needs exist on an ongoing basis often with limited funds.

15 We thank God for progress of the TWR mission in the region of West & Central Africa – spanning from the Democratic Republic of Congo in Central Africa to Mali in the north of West Africa.

16 Today is Youth Day in South Africa. Pray for TWR-KZN as it is going deeper through research on problems youth are facing, and ministering specifically to children. Pray that the

Hope for our Children radio programmes, produced by TWR KZN, will minister to many child-headed homes.

17 Pray for the volunteers at the KZN office. Many are searching for job opportunities as they look after their families and their needs.

18 Continue to pray for blessings, wisdom and strength for Eberhard Haberkorn and Gottfried Schiele as they will be attending several concerts, church services and various meetings with Radio stations and ERF-Namibia Board meeting next month.

19 Praise God for the progress made thus far regarding the Oasis Transmitter Project. Ask God to provide for the needs towards the completion of the project as well as the smooth preparations for the first broadcasts.

20 Pray for doors to be opened for Zulu programme distribution to FM stations and church groups.

21 Praise God that the solar panel project at WATS was successfully completed and is helping to provide auxiliary power, cutting costs on electricity.

22 The mid-year break takes place this month in South African schools. Ask the Lord for safe travels and that parents and learners take time to listen to TWR programmes.

23 Today Gottfried Schiele and Nathan Dunlop are celebrating their birthdays. Ask God to enfold them with strength, courage and knowledge as they serve the Lord faithfully together with their families.

24 Angelika Haberkorn is celebrating her birthday today. Pray that the Lord would be close to her as she serves Him with her husband, Eberhard.

25 Pray that the Church and its leaders will grow in spiritual maturity and Biblical understanding as TWR continues to reach out to Mozambique. Pray that the difficult circumstances in the country will serve to strengthen the people and that God will bring healing over the land.

26 Today the world observes an International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking. Currently, a TWR Women of Hope drama series that addresses issues of human trafficking is available in English and Romanian. Pray for funding so that more language translations can be developed.

27 Praise God for TWR ministry in Angola and that its radio ministry continues to be a powerful platform for taking the Gospel to the people who are in remote and poorer areas of Angola.

28 Pray for families in Africa separated because of economic struggles that force many who are unemployed to seek work outside their countries, leaving their children with grandparents or others.

29 Please pray for inspiration needed in the making of new programmes which will inspire change in the lives of our listeners. May God use TWR’s programmes to touch more lives in need of hope.

30 Pray that God will strengthen the partnership between Radio Trans Mundial (RTM) Mozambique and RTM Brazil and that this partnership will result in expansion of the TWR Mozambique ministry and the saving of millions of souls for Christ.
