**3** Today is International Day of Innocent Children - Victims of Aggression. Please pray for God to bring enlightenment to leaders of communities and teach parents about harmful cultural practices effecting lives of innocent children.

**4** TWR Presenter, Thulani Mdletshe, is celebrating his birthday today. We ask the Lord to richly bless and keep him and fill his life with joy, strength and courage.

**5** Thank God for the additional FM stations in the province of KwaZulu Natal (KZN) in South Africa, that are broadcasting *Sakha Indonda*, a Zulu programme for men.

**6** Thank God for children's programmes that are now being broadcast in more areas of KZN through additional FM network stations. Pray that Zulu children in the province will find hope through these broadcasts.

**7** We thank God for the successful launch of the Zulu *Thuru the Bible (TTB)* listener group from a secular FM Station airing our Zulu TTB programme, *Amazwi Okuphila*, in the capital city of KZN, South Africa.

**8** Ask God for growing audience interaction with Zulu programme listeners and listener groups.

**9** Praise the Lord for the successful selection of presenters for the TTB Igbo and Baoule languages. Pray for wisdom for them and the production teams in Nigeria and Abidjan as they embark on this five-year production.

**10** Today is the World Day to Combat Desertification and Drought. We pray particularly for the farming areas in African countries where there are still drought conditions. We give thanks for those countries actively involved in combating desertification in Africa. May God bless their efforts and restore their land.

**11** Praise God for the Afrikaans TTB programme *Die Bybel vir Vandag*, broadcast from Channel 7 in Namibia. Thank God for this wonderful opportunity to reach the Afrikaans-speaking community and the willingness of the radio station to broadcast the programme.

**12** Please pray for the radio broadcasts into Nigeria, that listenership will continue to increase and that more souls will come to know the Lord through the messages.

**20** Pray that God will guide the TWR West and Central Africa programme producers in the compilation and production process. May the presentation in West African languages reach the hearts of listeners and draw souls to the Kingdom.

**21** Please pray for the TWR Africa National Partners who make programmes available in the heart languages of their respective regions.

**22** Let us pray for all West-African people who do not know Jesus to be drawn to God through TWR broadcasts.
