

1 Please pray for Eberhard Haberkorn as he will be visiting Namibia from 1-12 August together with former KZN Board chair Martin Stobwasser. They will visit churches and Bible study groups that support the Southern Africa TWR German ministry, and conduct seminars in various locations.

2 Pray for TWR Donors in South Africa; that God will continue to bless them so that they can be a blessing.

3 Please pray for the five new TWT (*Truth for Today*) languages in production. They are Goun, Juba Arabic, Senoufo, Kirundi and Yao.

4 Pray for the new Donor Relations Data Base being installed at TWR Africa; that all records will be transferred successfully from the old data base.

5 God's Holy Spirit to change the hearts of leaders involved in conflicts and rebellions throughout West and Central Africa and end the suffering and turmoil destroying communities and families.

6 Please pray for the TTB Lingala production team in the DRC. Pray for wisdom as they work towards a 6-month lead before airing commences in August.

7 We often receive messages from young listeners in Africa who are caught up in sexual sin. Please pray for these young people. Pray God raises up mentors to disciple them towards a healthy, full relationship with Jesus Christ.

8 Pray for the TWR Africa Donor Relations Representatives as they maintain relationships with donors.

9 Today is Women's day in South Africa. Please pray that the TWR Women of Hope programmes will encourage and equip mothers throughout the continent to persevere, even in difficult circumstances. Pray that fathers and children will acknowledge and honour godly mothers on this day.

10 Pray for strength and good health for the Africa media services team as they work to ensure that programmes go on air problem free. There is a lot that happens in the background before programmes go on air on our various transmitters.

11 Pray for the many listeners who are unemployed. We pray that they are encouraged by the teaching on our platforms. Pray for opportunities and employment for them.

12 Many parts of Africa have been experiencing drought for some time now. Please pray for the TWR listeners in those areas, and that God will send rain.

13 As more FM stations across Africa are broadcasting our programmes, please pray that many new listeners to our "*Living Word for Africa*" (English African version of Dr J Vernon McGee's *Thru the Bible* programme) will grow in knowledge of God's Word and in their relationship with God.

14 Pray for TWR listeners to understand their need for God's forgiveness and the hope He offers through a relationship with him once they have accepted Jesus as their personal Saviour, and that they will understand the concepts of grace, forgiveness, and repentance.

15 Pray that the Swaziland broadcasts to East Africa will have a clear signal, and that many listeners in that region will tune in and hear the Word of God.

16 We pray for the people in African countries such as Ethiopia, Eritrea, Mauritania, and many more to have the freedom to choose their religion, express personal beliefs, distribute literature, and listen to Christian radio programmes.

17 Pray that the Church and its leaders in Mozambique will grow in spiritual maturity and Biblical understanding. Pray that as TWR continues to reach out to Mozambique, our broadcasts will strengthen the people in Mozambique and that God will bring healing over the land and spiritually nourish them.

18 Pray for ever increasing spiritual growth amongst TWR staff. May the Lord nurture us into a deeper understanding of servanthood and humility.

19 Pray for the TWR Zimbabwe ministry and thank God that a good channel for sending radios to Zimbabwe has been established.

20 Praise God for TWR's ministry in Angola and that its radio ministry continues to be a powerful platform for taking the gospel to people in remote and poor areas who can't read the Bible for themselves. Angola, among other challenges faces, rampant poverty and soaring unemployment.

21 Pray for the various ministry areas at TWR-KZN (*Building, Finance, IT, Communications, Media and Human Resources*). Pray that God will continue to provide resources.

22 Pray for inspiration needed in the making of new programmes which will inspire change in the lives of our listeners. May God use TWR's programmes to touch more lives in need of Hope.

23 Pray that TWR listeners in Egypt continue to put their trust in God as the country faces water scarcity problem due to the uneven water distribution, misuse of water resources, inefficient irrigation techniques and growing population.

24 Bring to the Lord TWR's team in KZN as they diligently seek to reach Zulu people with the Gospel.

25 TWR360 breaks down barriers of language and accessibility so users can download, stream and read abundant Christian media resources. Pray that many across the world will discover and use this effective ministry tool.

26 Continue to pray for *Women of Hope* funding in Uganda, Zimbabwe, Rwanda and Burundi.

27 Pray for additional funds needed for TWR Zimbabwe to be able to air our programmes on local FM stations.

28 Continue to pray for wisdom for the Swaziland Transmitting Station team as they deal with all technical aspects at the station as well as the maintenance of the building, grounds and transmitting towers.

29 We keep praying that God will speedily grant us an FM license in Ivory Coast, to help us reach out better to the spiritual needs of the local populace who are thirsting for the pure Word of God.

30 We also give God glory for raising voices from the international community for our Christian brethren in Nigeria, who have undergone untold persecutions.

31 Let us continue to pray for our neighbours, that God will reveal Himself to them through our programmes.
