

Prayer calendar for September 2018



- 1 Please pray for all the young TWR listeners across Africa who are preparing for exams, either at school or college level.
- 2 Pray for the Global Fund Development Team; that they will persevere, even during these tough economic times.
- 3 Pray for partner/production offices in Africa that face challenges which hinders them from doing ministry. Factors include but are not limited to, power outages, illness, internet shut down by government etc.
- 4 Please pray for the finances of South African TWR listeners, as the economy in South Africa is weakening, causing the cost of living to increase significantly.
- 5 Praise God that more churches get on board with *Women of Hope* South Africa and start prayer groups in their areas. Please pray that these prayer groups will be diligent in prayer and encourage others to pray with them.
- 6 Pray for people to translate the monthly prayer calendar into other South African languages. So far they are available in English, Afrikaans, German, Xhosa and Zulu.
- 7 Pray for much needed funds to be able to produce the *Women of Hope* programme in Zulu and Xhosa.
- 8 Pray for radio stations to air our programs at reasonable hours to increase listenership.
- 9 Pray for James and Lyn Burnett visiting their supporting churches and friends in September. At the same time they will visit the Eastern and Western Cape to notify people of the new Xhosa *Women of Hope* programmes.
- 10 Praise the Lord for the Xhosa team who have produced Xhosa *Women of Hope* programmes. They are needing funds to attend the launch and to be able to interact with Xhosa speakers.
- 11 Pray that listeners of TWR programmes will have their needs met, be strengthened in faith and be greatly blessed in all areas of their lives – and that they get clear reception of programme broadcasts as they tune in.
- 12 West and Central Africa needs the Gospel now more than ever. Please pray that God will inspire and direct TWR on the best way to channel its strengths in such a way that it will bring in a great harvest of souls.
- 13 Praise God for TWR Africa supporters and pray that they can continue supporting the ministry financially even in these hard times.
- 14 Please pray for all our producing partners in Africa. Pray that God will continue to grant them zeal and the resources needed to produce programmes successfully.
- 15 Pray for the West African Transmitting Station (*WATS*), that God will continue to bless the team that are devoted to the smooth running of this station, granting them more grace to continue in their selfless sacrifice to the advancement of the Kingdom of God in the West of Africa.
- 16 Pray for additional funding needed for health programmes and for new programmes at TWR in Zimbabwe.
- 17 Praise God that VOC (*Voice of the Church*), TWR National partner in Swaziland, launched their English channel (VOC 2)

on 22 June 2018 in addition to their Siswati channel (VOC 1). Pray that God will open more opportunities for the station to air its programmes on local FM stations.

18 Praise God for the Litala Iya Umi (*The Way of Life*) programme that is airing from our TWR transmitting station in Swaziland and the listener responses. Pray for the continuation of its broadcast.

19 Pray for our various producers, that God's grace will abound more and more upon their lives and God's divine security upon their families.

20 Please pray for political and economic stability in East Africa so that needed resources, medical care, and food supplies can be made available to women and their families. Pray also for refugees and internally displaced people who desire to resettle in a safe place.

21 Pray that TWR Africa could reach a large proportion of the people of Nigeria should an additional broadcast license be granted. Please pray that God will open the hearts of the authorities to issue the license.

22 Please pray for East African leaders to provide the desperately needed clean drinking water and sanitation facilities to prevent deadly diseases that claim the lives of millions every year.

23 Continue to pray for rain through the drought-stricken areas in Southern Africa.

24 Today is Heritage Day in South Africa and it presents an opportunity for South Africans to reconnect and recommit themselves to develop a better Africa and a better world. Pray for TWR Africa ministry as it broadcasts indigenous programmes throughout the continent.

25 Pray for the TWR Africa presenters who are responsible for programme continuity and also present the 100% Worship live radio programme every weekday.

26 Pray for leaders in Africa to educate policy makers, media personnel, employers, and society concerning the value of women and baby girls so that harmful cultural practices would change.

27 As the schools in South Africa are closing for the third semester break. Ask that the Lord will protect those travelling and as people have time to listen to TWR programmes, that their lives be changed.
